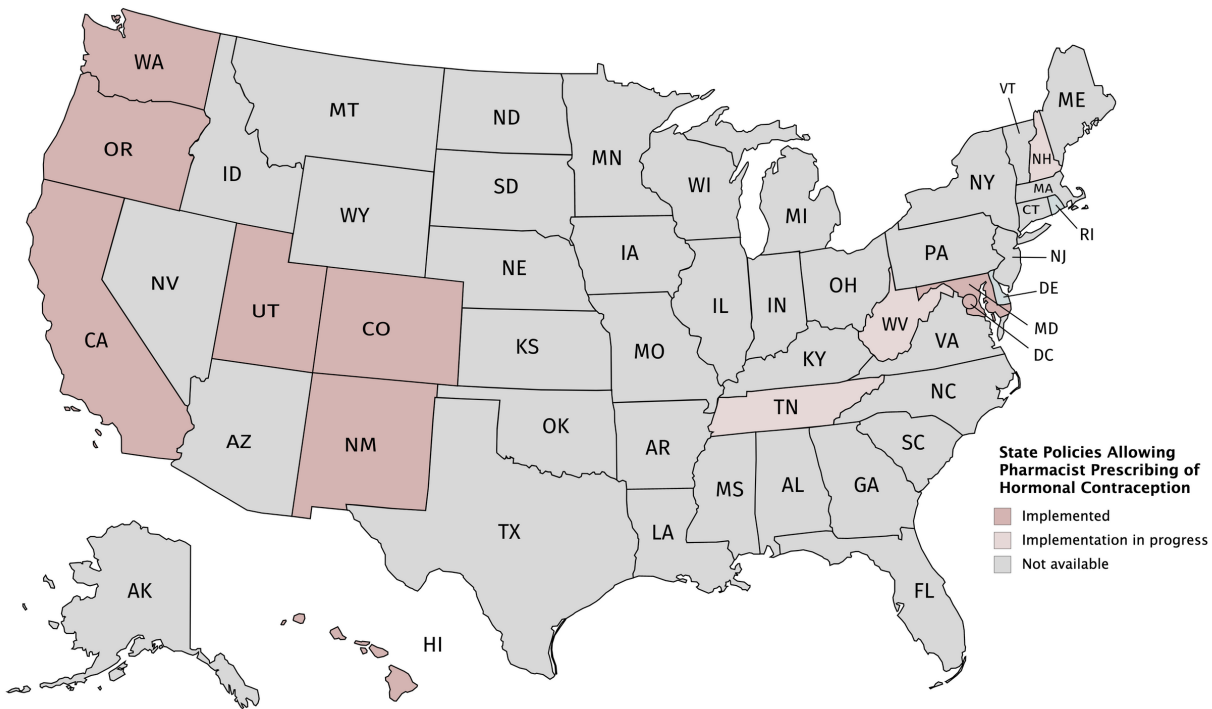
## BIPARTISAN SUPPORT
